

STREET ACCESS PERMIT DECLARATIONS

First: The Applicant represents all parties in interest and shall furnish material, do all work, pay all costs, and shall in a reasonable length of time restore the damaged portions of the right-of-way to condition similar or equal to that existing before the commencement of the described work, including any seeding or sodding necessary.

Second: The proposed work shall be located and constructed to the satisfaction of the Building Commissioner. No revisions or additions shall be made to the proposed work on the right-of-way without the written permission of the Building Commissioner.

Third: The Applicant shall at all time conduct the work in such a manner as to minimize hazards to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Traffic controls and work site protection shall be in accordance with the applicable requirements of Chapter 6 (Traffic Controls for Highway Construction and Maintenance Operations) of the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Street and Highways and with the traffic control plan if one is required elsewhere in the permit. All signs, barricades, flaggers, etc. required for traffic control shall be furnished by the Applicant. Work shall be done on any day except Sunday, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Work shall be done only during day light hours.

Fourth: The work performed by the Applicant is for the bona fide purpose expressed and not for the purpose of, nor will result in, the parking or servicing of vehicles on the Village right-of-way. Signs located on or overhanging the right-of-way shall be prohibited.

Fifth: The Permittee agrees to indemnify and hold the Village and its officers, officials, employees, and agents harmless from and against any and all claims or liabilities arising from, related to, or connected with, either directly or indirectly, this driveway access/street access permit, provided that said claims are not the result of grossly negligent or intentional act or omission of the Village or its officers, officials, employees, or agents.

Sixth: The Applicant shall not trim, cut, or in any way disturb any trees or shrubbery in the right-of-way without the approval of the Building Commissioner or his duly authorized representative.

Seventh: The Village reserves the right to make charges, additions, repairs and relocation within its statutory limits to the facilities constructed under this permit on their appurtenances on the right-of-way as may at any time be considered necessary to permit relocation, reconstruction, widening, or maintaining of the street and/or to provide proper protection to life and property on or adjacent to the Village right-of-way. However, in the event this permit is granted to construct, locate, operate and maintain utility facilities in the Village right-of-way, the Applicant, upon written request by the Building Commissioner shall perform such alterations or changes of location of the facilities, without expense to the Village and should the Applicant fail to make satisfactory arrangements to comply with this request within a reasonable time, the Village reserves the right to make such alterations or changes of location or remove the work, and the Applicant agrees to pay for the cost incurred.

Eighth: This permit is effective only insofar as the Village has jurisdiction and does not presume to release the Applicant from compliance with the provisions of any existing statutes or local regulations relating to the construction of such work.

Ninth: The construction of access driveways is subject to the regulations listed in the Ordinance for Access Driveways. In the future, the land use of property served by an access driveway described and constructed in accordance with this permit changes so as to require a higher driveway type as defined in that the owner shall apply for a new permit and bear the costs for such revisions as may be required to conform to the regulations listed in Ordinance.

Tenth: The Applicant affirms that the property lines on the attached sheet(s) are true and correct and binds and obligates himself to perform the operation in accordance with the description and attached sketch or plan, and to abide by the Ordinance requirements.
