

NEW ROUTE NAME Route 570 – Fox Lake - CLC

In addition to the new name, Route 570 will no longer operate between the College of Lake County (CLC) and Gurnee Mills (this section will be taken over by Route 565). On Saturdays, Route 570 will operate as a large loop, offering new access to shopping destinations on Rollins Road in Round Lake Beach, but not offering any service west of Fairfield Road. Route 570 will still operate on the current 60-minute frequency during the same hours of service, but departure times may change.

Route 571 – Zion

This route will have minor routing changes. Any trip that departs downtown Waukegan on the half-hour will operate via a new alignment in Zion, which will terminate at 23rd and Gabriel. The timing of departures will mostly remain the same, but minor schedule changes will occur.

NEW ROUTE NAME Route 572 – Washington

This route will no longer operate south of the College of Lake County (CLC, see map). Route 572 will operate every 30 minutes on weekdays and every 60 minutes on Saturdays. Fewer trips will operate via Gages Lake Road, with most buses staying on Washington Street from CLC to downtown Waukegan. Service on Route 572 will operate directly to/from the Waukegan Metra station. Passengers wishing to transfer to Route 572 from other routes in downtown Waukegan should make the transfer at Washington/Genesee. School-day only service to Carmel High School will continue to be a part of this route. Eastbound Route 572 buses will not always directly serve the main bus station in Waukegan; when this occurs, passengers transferring to other buses should exit the arriving bus on Washington Street at Sheridan. These routing changes are shown on the map included in this brochure.

NEW ROUTE Route 574 – CLC – Westfield Hawthorn

This **new route** will operate between the College of Lake County (CLC) and Westfield Hawthorn Mall. This route will follow the same route as the southern portion of the current Route 572. The new Route 574 will operate about once per hour, Monday through Saturday.

Round Lake Area Call-n-Ride

This service will continue to operate in the same service area from 6:00am-6:15pm Monday-Friday, but the scheduled stop times at College of Lake County will change to facilitate better connections to other routes.

Vernon Hills – Mundelein Call-n-Ride

This service will continue to operate in the same service area from 6:00am-6:15pm Monday-Friday, but the scheduled stop times at Westfield Hawthorn Mall will change to facilitate better connections to other routes.

New downtown Waukegan posted stops at designated boarding and alighting locations

Starting December 22, 2013, all routes serving downtown Waukegan will operate under the **partial posted-stops-only** policy. In the downtown Waukegan area ONLY, passengers will be able to get on (board) and off (alight) only at Pace posted bus stop signs. Look for this symbol on printed schedules, indicating that a route operates on a partial posted-stop-only policy.



LAKE COUNTY TRANSIT RESTRUCTURING INITIATIVE SERVICE IMPROVEMENT GUIDE December 22, 2013

Working to Improve Service in Lake County

With the increase of activity occurring in the Central Lake County region, Pace will implement a new bus route network in order to provide better and more reliable service to residents and businesses in the area. The goal of this project is to increase frequency on routes that are experiencing overcrowding, improve our on-time performance, and increase connectivity in west-central Lake County. There are also new timed connections at the College of Lake County. Because of the magnitude of changes pertaining to this project, the completed restructuring will be implemented in two phases: Phase 1 will be implemented on December 22, 2013, and Phase 2 will be implemented in March, 2014.

Changes to the following routes are detailed in this brochure, including a map of all of the routes that will be altered as a result of this initiative: 563, 564, 565, 568, 570, 571, 572, and 574, with time changes made to Routes 272, 561, 562, 569 and the Vernon Hills-Mundelein and Round Lake Area Call-n-Rides. Additionally, a new posted stops only policy will be in effect for the downtown Waukegan area. Route 272 - Milwaukee Avenue North

This route will continue to operate as frequently as currently scheduled (every 30 minutes during weekday peak periods, every 60 minutes at off-peak hours, and every 60 minutes on Saturdays), but will have noticeable schedule changes on weekdays. The routing of the buses will not change.

Route 563 - Great Lakes Naval Station

This route will have a minor route change. Northbound buses on Belvidere Road will turn north onto Genesee (not Sheridan), then will turn right on Washington and then left on Sheridan to access their downtown Waukegan terminal. There will also be some minor schedule changes. All connections/transfers that are currently available will remain.

For detailed routing and scheduling information, please see the Route 563 schedule dated December 23, 2013.

Route 564 - Jackson / 14th

This route will have a minor route change. Eastbound buses on Belvidere Road will turn north onto Genesee (not Sheridan), then will turn right on Washington and then left on Sheridan to access their downtown Waukegan terminal. There will also be some minor schedule changes. All connections/transfers that are currently available will remain.

For detailed routing and scheduling information, please see the Route 564 schedule dated December 23, 2013.

Route 565 - Grand Avenue

This route will extend west to the College of Lake County in Grayslake via Grand Avenue and US45 (these routing changes are shown on the map included in this brochure). Additionally, Route 565 will operate every 30 minutes for most of the day, and will operate later in the evening on weeknights. The routing around Gurnee Mills will also change. Eastbound Route 565 buses will not always directly serve the main bus station in Waukegan; when this occurs, passengers transferring to other buses should exit the arriving bus on Washington Street at Sheridan.

Route 568 - Belvidere

This route will have a minor route change. Eastbound buses on Belvidere Road will turn north onto Genesee (not Sheridan), then will turn right on Washington and then left on Sheridan to access their downtown Waukegan terminal. There will also be some minor schedule changes. All connections/transfers that are currently available will remain.


Route 569 - Lewis

This route will not have any major route changes, though some trips will follow a different path when leaving from Waukegan High School - Brookside Campus. However, the frequency for Route 569 will reduce to every 60 minutes during the midday and many other trips will have minor time changes.
