The Grayslake Police Department was notified on January 19, 2017 at 11:34 am of a suspicious incident that occurred on January 18, 2017 at 3:20 pm. The incident occurred in the area of Frederick Road and Frederick School.

It was reported by a student that a newer tan or brown in color SUV / van, stopped on Frederick Road near the school and the driver motioned for the student to come towards the vehicle. The suspect is described as a white male, middle aged, with reddish brown hair that is combed forward and stubble on his face.

The student did not approach the vehicle and turned around and headed back towards the school. Upon the student turning back towards the school, the driver left the area. The driver never attempted to exit the vehicle or make further contact with the student.

The police department is actively investigating this incident and is planning to increase patrols in the area. The police department encourages parents to discuss with their children actions they should take in situations like these.
